



Statement of Intent Relating to Event Safety

Definitions

Series co-ordinator – that member of the East Midlands Cycle Racing League Committee tasked with co-ordinating the series. The series co-ordinator will register the events with the necessary governing body, communicate results to the governing body where required and complete any financial documents required on completion of the events

Evening Organiser – a named person who will act as the organiser on the night of the event. Duties include, but are not limited to, track setup, supporting signing on, ensuring safety measures are in place and being followed, finish judging, leaving the venue in a clean and tidy state

Statement of Intent

Safety is the main priority at Mallory Park RR League events.

The evening organiser for the Mallory Park RR League events accepts and shows a duty of care responsibility for the safety of the event. In particular, all reasonable precautions will be taken to ensure the safety of;

- Active participants
- Spectators and Organising Officials

The evening organiser for Mallory Park RR League events will have been provided with a risk assessment which demonstrates that a pre-event plan was in place and suitable consideration has been given to ensure the safety of the categories of people identified above.

The evening organiser will have reviewed the risk assessment and clearly understand their responsibilities with regard to it in minimising potential incidents.

The evening organiser will inform the series co-ordinator should they believe any additions are required to the risk assessment.

The evening organiser will avoid the risk of damage to property and minimise any environmental impacts.

The commissaire have reviewed the risk assessment prior to the event and will enforce the safety measures identified in the risk assessment.

The race will not start until qualified first aid is in place.
